Our programme of talks and visits will enable you to learn more about our town and the local area. Each September the Society organises the annual Heritage Open Days event in the town. Many historic properties open their doors to everyone for this event, and we also organise a number of guided walks around the wider neighbourhood. Members are recruited to act as stewards at some of these properties. We also place blue plaques on buildings of historic importance in the Town.



## PARTICIPATE IN THE COMMUNITY



The Society is a vital civic hub with links to – and representation on – important local organisations including Cirencester Town Council, Cirencester Community Development Trust, Cotswold District Council and other local conservation groups as well as national bodies like Civic Voice. The Society makes representations to the local planning authorities to ensure the highest standards of planning and conservation, and supports imaginative developments.



## EXPLORE THE TOWN



We produce a self guided Town Trail and our members act as town walk guides throughout the year, especially during the summer months. We also conduct walks by arrangement with groups- small and large. We are always looking for new guides to help reduce the workload. The modest charge for the walks helps our income.
